Life Groups (Doing Life Together)

I am so excited to announce what is on the schedule for Life Groups this year. First of all, the Worship Committee has chosen an amazing study for the Life Groups this year. We will be going through a RightNow Media series taught by Francis Chan called "Jesus' Farewell Message". In this 6-part series, Francis Chan dives into John 13–17, a passage rich in promises, commands, and eternal truths.
