Are YOU willing to receive the Word of God?

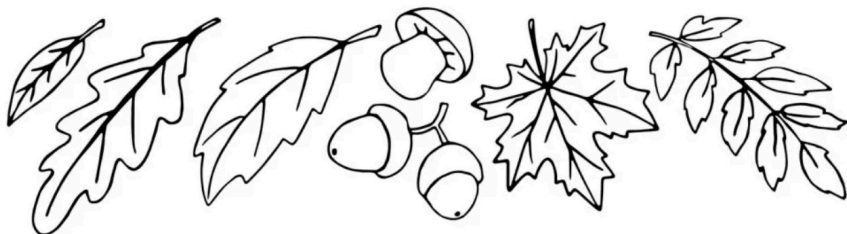
