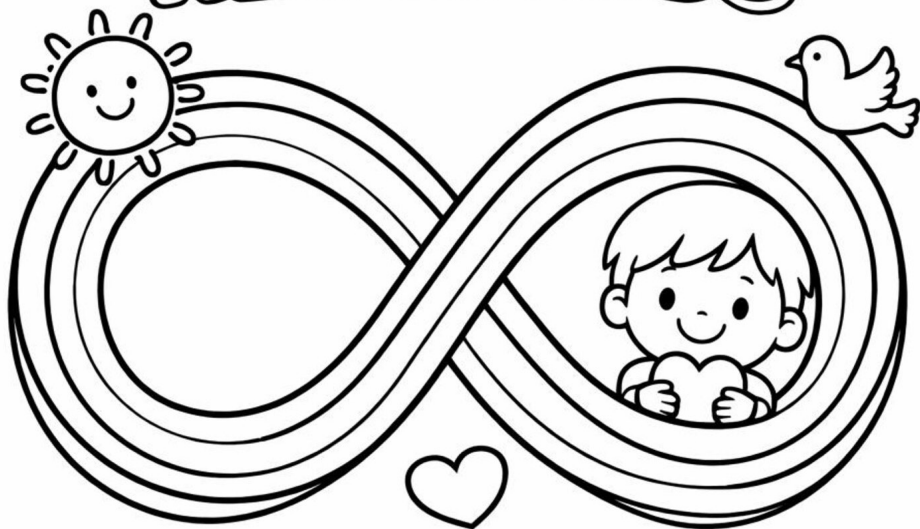
Let us remember our friends and family in our prayers:
