The Jr. RCYF will be having their annual Mother's Day cake silent auction on May 10.

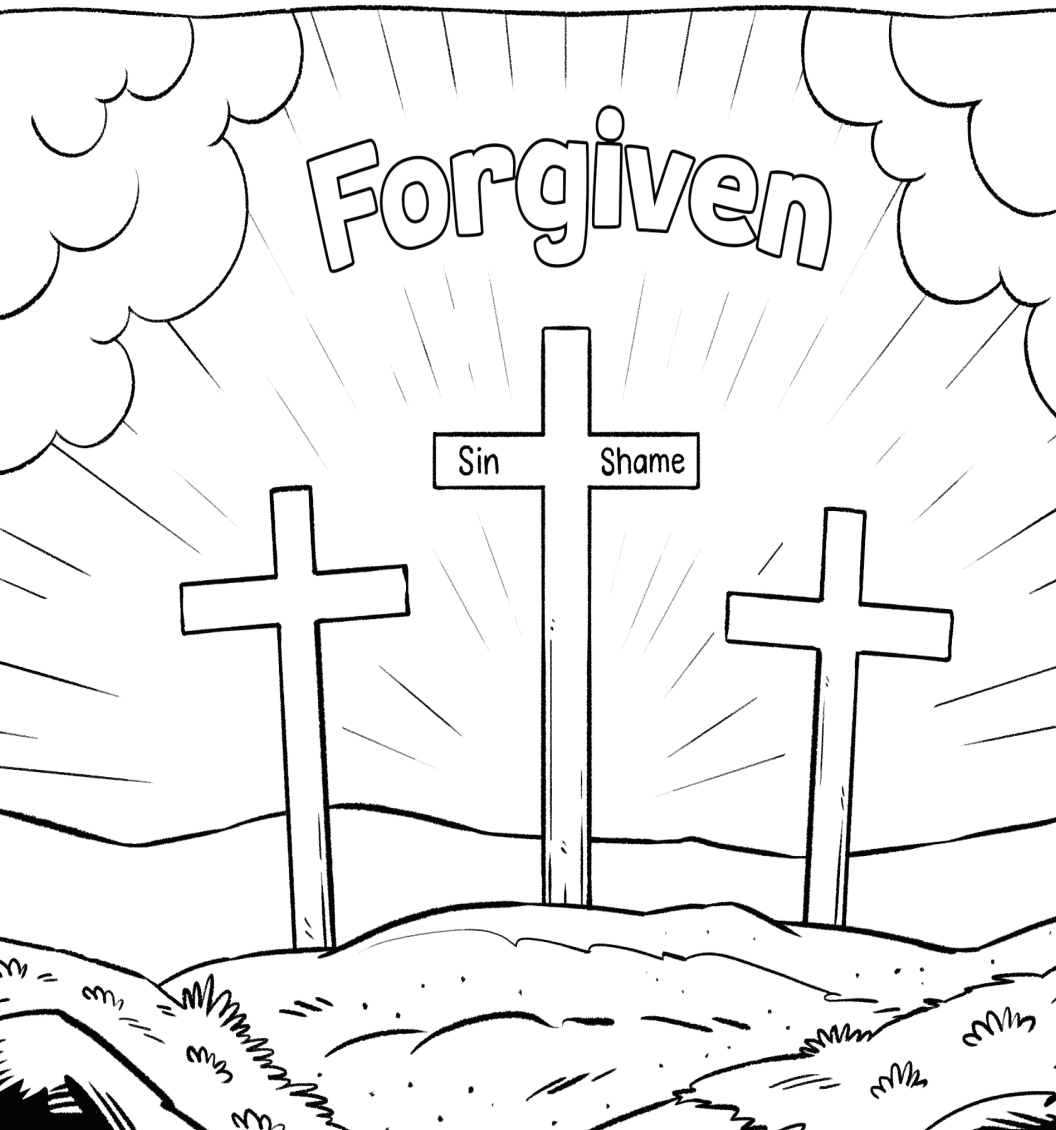
PRAYER CONCERNS
